

## HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMS AT OHR KODESH

We've made improvements in High School learning opportunities at Ohr Kodesh. We have new faculty, new courses and expanded scheduling. Here's what's in store:

Michlala – We're still meeting Wednesday nights from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Dinner will end promptly at 6:30. There will be two 40-minute classes; the first period will be a required, grade-level text based class (mostly related to Tanach [Bible] or Rabbinic Literature, taught using English translation of the text) and a second period seminar-style class. Courses in the past few years have included an overview of Jewish History, the History of Zionism, a survey of Jewish Music, the Biblical Story of David, Survey of American Jewish Short Stories. Classes for this fall will be announced in August. Michlala begins on October 13<sup>th</sup>.

Shoresh Hebrew High School– This is our intensive, text study program. The Shoresh curriculum is composed for four 40-minute classes that will be on Sunday evenings from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. The Shoresh program will study Tanach (Bible), Jewish History, the Siddur (prayer book) for fluency and understanding and rabbinic texts. **Tanach, siddur and Rabbinics will be taught using original texts in Hebrew**, with English being the language of instruction.
