4. Please sign your child in and out of childcare. We do not allow children to walk alone back to services to look for their parents.
5. Please let us know on the sign-in sheet if your child has any special needs, including food allergies.
6. Fabringen will provide plenty of nut-free snacks but please feel free to drop off additional snacks or a packed lunch with your child.
